This month was eventful with elections and many fruitful meetings.

Firstly, my hearty congratulations to all the members who have contested and won the elections viz State President Elect 2022 Dr. Senthamil Pari, State President Elect 2023 – Dr. Abul Hasan, State Secretary Elect – Dr. NRTR. Thiyagarajan, State Vice President South Zone – Dr. Amuthan and Paramedical Joint Secretary – Dr. Thirumavalavan.

My hearty congratulations to all the other office bearers who were elected unopposed.

I wish you all, the very best and a very successful tenure. And to all the runners up, I appreciate your efforts and wish you more luck.

I immensely appreciate and congratulate our Election Committee Chairman Dr. Mohandoss, returning office officer Dr. A.K. Ravikumar, Observer Dr. LP. Thangavelu and the other team members Dr. Jesudas, Dr. Balasundaram, Dr. Rajendran for their untiring efforts in the successful, democratic and transparent conduct of the online elections.

The process involved a lot of preparatory meetings and rehearsals before the actual process and I was there with the team at every step.

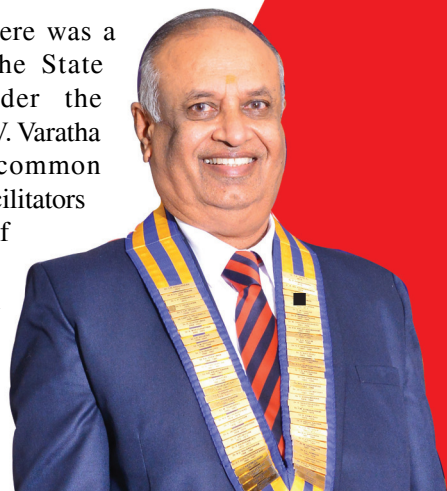
The man of the show, our election commissioner Dr. Mohandoss, Dr. A.K. Ravikumar and Myself were present along with the conducting agency ECS headed by Mr. Sasikumar on 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September at the JVL Plaza. We were always there to answer any queries of our members including the link and the procedure. The election process ended at 5pm on the 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and counting was

commenced immediately in the presence of the candidates or their authorized representatives as requested by the contestants.

The results were declared to the contestants, acknowledgements were obtained from the winners and certificates were issued. The election process was very well appreciated by our members and I thank all the members for their participation.

Next, my warm appreciations to the Facts finding Committee Chairman Dr. Kanagasabapathy, Convenor Dr. C.N Raja and the other committee members for their relentless work in collecting and consolidating various documents and data from 2007 which is indeed a Herculean task. They were ably assisted by our Lawyer, Forensic and regular auditors and the investigating officer, asst public prosecutor and other officials. The committee has submitted two large volumes of book with nine annexures and a cd containing the full details of the financial irregularities. The Chairman wanted to dissolve and quit from the committee since his work was over. However, myself, state office bearers and the state council members, refused to accept his request stating that his services are invaluable in recovery of the finances including any future clarifications by the legal team. The Chairman, convenor and the team were honored for their commendable job and I only hope that we get to see the light soon.

On 09.10.2021 there was a meeting between the State office bearers under the guidance of Prof. Dr. V. Varatha rajan with the common Biomedical waste Facilitators Association of TamilNadu, regarding tariff revision which



has been pending for more than 4 years. The meeting was fruitful and an amicable settlement was reached after several hours of discussion, for a uniform tariff for our entire state with immediate implementation.

**The key details are as follows:**

- a. Hospitals < 100 beds, only bed charges at Rs.8 per bed
- b. Irrespective of the no of beds, if the biomedical waste is more than 250gms per bed, charges will be levied on weight basis ie Rs. 32/- per kg.
- c. Collection of biomedical waste should be 50% or more no of days in a month
- d. If the collection of biomedical waste is less than 15 days in a month, no fee will be paid.
- e. General waste should not be mixed with biomedical waste
- f. Monthly bills should be raised.
- g. Uniform rates for collecting bags were also fixed.
- h. There should not be any complaints from the Pollution control board, Nursing home board and the Government.
- i. Clinics – (a) Rs 900/- for part time clinics and Rs 1300/- for full time clinics with biomedical waste generation. (b) Clinics with no injection or dressing facilities need not get BMW authorization.

At this point I would emphasize, the Nursing Home Board to act swiftly and encourage renewal of all the pending registrations of the hospitals, update the existing database and also increase the new memberships.

The 310th State council meeting was held at Thanjavur. The Thanjavur IMA Branch had made elaborate and wonderful arrangements and I heartily appreciate their efforts. Their hospitality was commendable. Prior to the state council meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021, the Thanjavur IMA branch had arranged for the Doctors day celebrations which was conducted in a well-organized manner. They were wonderful hosts taking care of the entire contingent for three days.

The 310th state council meeting was action packed and well attended and I would like to

mention a few salient ones. Our National President Dr. J.A. Jayalal, participated in the meeting and offered his inputs. The election results were handed over by the Election commissioner to me and I officially announced the results. The Election commissioner honored the team members for their undaunting work.

As already mentioned earlier the Facts finding committee was asked to stay on and continue their work in helping recover the assets.

Regarding audit of the state office accounts, three more members will be added in the finance standing committee from three other zones who will audit and submit the reports to the Finance standing committee Chairman.

The PPLSS Chairman Dr. K. Thangamuthu was fittingly honored for his mammoth and laudable pioneering work of protecting the Doctor community from legal implications.

It was proposed to conduct National CGP conference and National Women Doctors wing conference on 21.11.2021 at Thambaram, Chennai.

As regards to the membership drive, both the State and Centre are offering a huge discount (single member Rs. 9500/- and couple members Rs.15000/-). I request all the members of our association to actively participate in this drive and each one can induct a new member so that the strength of our association increases and so also the members can benefit. A special award is awaiting the branch that inducts more new members.

The covid pandemic had slowed down the entire world for the past two years but we the Doctor community and the other frontline workers have worked relentlessly with more vigor in guarding our fellowmen. Slowly and steadily we are beating the pandemic.

The festival of lights is fast approaching and I wish everyone love, light, health and happiness not only on Diwali day but every day. Wishing you all a Safe and Happy Deepawali.

- ▶ See to it that all HCF who generate BMW have
  - MOU with Common Facilitator
  - BMW authorization from PCB
  - Follow BMW Rules 2016
  - CEA Certification

Those HCF who do not comply these are liable for fine - Environmental Compensation which may run into lakhs calculating retrospectively from the date of commencement of the HCF

- BMW disposal : Meeting with all the Common facilitators to have uniformity across the state was conducted and fruitful outcomes obtained.



- STPs / ETPs : HBI Core Committee met the Hon'ble Environmental Union Minister & represented the issues pertaining to STPs & ETPs in all HCF & website for each HCF to upload the Bio Waste Disposal Records . CPCB agreed.

a) Wherever there is Common STPs for the entire City / Town / Village, pretreatment with sodium Hypochlorite is enough before discharging the liquid waste into common drainage system.

b) PCB will have a common website into which HCF need to upload the BMW Disposal Records. I was part of the HBI team in discussion with CPCB officials.

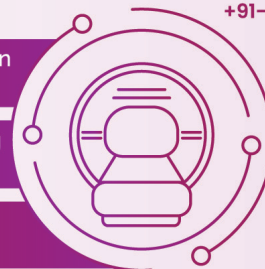

# 14 NOVEMBER WORLD DIABETES DAY

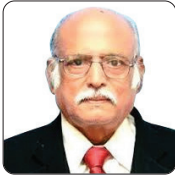

**Detailed discussion and deliberations were made among the members present and following decisions were taken in consensus**

1. IMA TNSB with NHB TNSB Wings will be authority to finalise and bring out uniform decisions regarding BMW and Pollution Control Issues Pertaining to IMA Members across the State for all the Branches and Stakeholders to follow
2. There should not be any complaints from either PCB/Public/Hospitals/clinics.
3. For hospitals
  - a. Irrespective of number of beds if BMW generation is >250 gms/ bed /per day charges will be on Weight basis.
  - b. If <250 gms / bed /per day charges will on per bed / day basis.
  - c. It is the collective responsibility of the Hospitals and Service providers to weigh the BMW, record and sign in the Register.
  - d. General waste should not be mixed with BMW
  - e. Rs. 8 / bed /day and Rs. 32/Kg
4. No Payment if their visits are less than 50%.
5. Clinics :
  - a. Visit should be at least twice a week.
  - b. Rs. 900 for part time clinics and Rs. 1300 for full time clinics per month.  
Two months Fee can be collected as Advance. Bills to be generated monthly and collect Payment
6. Consultation Rooms
  - a. Should not generate BMW.
  - b. No need for BMW disposal services.
7. Bags and Bar coding Rates:
  - a. Should be uniform for all Hospitals/ Clinics and will be fixed after studying the market.
8. Model Agreement
9. Immediate Effect – The above said decision will be effected immediately

### **Dear Friends**

First of all I thank Dr.Sasiraj, President of IMA Thanjavur and his office bearers for Honoring me at IMA State council meeting on 10.10.2021 at Thanjavur. I also profusely thank our past President Dr.S.Kanagasabapathy and our State President Dr.P.Ramakrishnan for honoring me on behalf of IMA Kumbakonam Branch and IMA Tamil Nadu State Branch, for my legal chairman services in PPLSSS. For past 15 years at IMA State council meeting on 10.10.2021 at Thanjavur.

In this issue, I am going to discuss about preserving the case sheets and other documents related to consumer cases and other cases already filed in the courts.

In Coimbatore one of the leading hospital owner of the same received a lawyer notice regarding one Ortho case. In that lawyer notice, patient accused the hospital owner and the Ortho surgeon for the failure of the surgery. After the lawyer notice, case was filed in the state forum against the hospital owner and the Ortho surgeon.

Our PPLSSS Lawyer filed affidavit on behalf of the Nursing home and the Ortho surgeon 2010 itself. Unfortunately, the owner of the hospital died nearly 9 years ago. Now the case came up for

hearing at the state forum. Lawyer wanted the original case sheet to be filed in the court. Now that particular hospital is managed by the deceased Doctor’s wife. Herself and the Ortho surgeon searched for the original case sheet. They could not find it out till now. So the case is pending in the court.

Yet another hospital has also same difficulty occur after taking over the charge of the hospital by the doctor’s son and his daughter in law happen to be both are doctors. In this case also after 7 years patient wants the copy of the case sheet and sent the notices through the Tamil Nadu Government, the collector and the Tamil Nadu Medical Council . Doctors tried their best to trace out the case sheet and couldn’t find it out till now.

What I want to impress upon you is, whenever any Doctor taking over the charge of the hospital from their parents or from anybody else, kindly take over the Medico Legal Cases properly and the list must be attested by taking over and handling over doctors, and the signed documents must be preserved till the case is over.

This is the lesson I learned from our members within this 3 months. I request you all to take notice of the above facts and proceed accordingly, while taking over and handing over the charge of the Hospital from others, including from your parents. **Thanking You.** ■

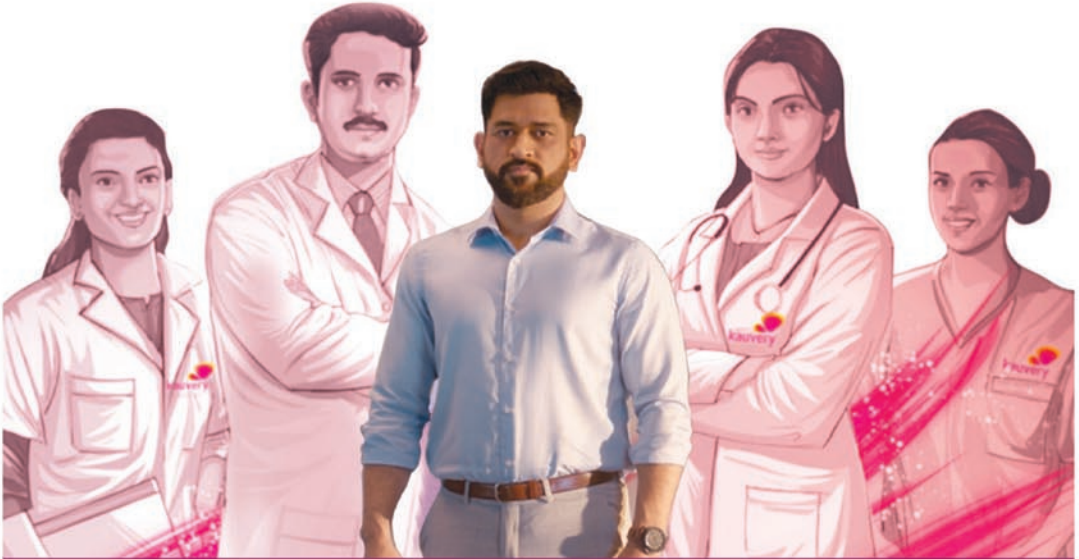
