Dear Friends Greetings to all !

We had two important events in this month of June, the details of which I wish to share with you.

1. National Insurance Summit: This summit was organised by Hospital Board of India, IMA TNSB and IMA NHB. We had one day workshop and another day Insurance Summit in which IMA National President National & State Leaders and members of General Insurance Council participated. IMA leaders also had a meeting with the members of General Insurance Council and the following suggestions were proposed for implementation.

a) Formation of a committee comprising IMA representatives and General Insurance Council. This committee shall work together to fix the package rates which are viable.

b) Persuading the Central Government through proper channels for the formation of Exclusive Insurance Redressal Tribunal which will enable the Insurer, Provider and the patients to approach to redress their grievances.

c) Inclusion of IMA representatives from diverse specialities to the General Insurance Council, by which they can coordinate with G.I.C in policy making processes. This will create a transparent and beneficial atmosphere among the providers (Hospitals).

d) Single portal for empanelment for all Private Insurance Companies.

e) All hospitals of IMA NHB should be empaneled by the Insurance Companies if they are eligible.

This is the first progressive step we initiated and we earnestly hope that in successive meetings we could achieve our goals.

2. Boot Camp: This Camp was Organised by IMA JDN and MSN with the Coordination of Dr.K.M.Abul Hasan, JDN National Chairman, Dr. Hariharan, JDN Chairman, Tamilnadu, Dr.G.S. Kumar and Dr. Jamuna Rani Chairman & Co Chairman of MSN respectively. This was a wonderful event with participation of more than 200 young doctors benefited with lectures rendered by our IMA stalwarts and

also through workshops on Suturing, BLS and ACLS.

Village Adoption Programme: I thank and congratulate the branches who adopted villages and executed medical camps and other community activities. We will have second phase of village adoption program on 25.06. 2023.

I request the branches of those who had not adopted villages to adopt at least one village and the branches who had already adopted a village, to do the projects.

My Dear Colleague, Greetings!

I hope this message finds you in good health. I would like to share with you some important matters relevant to IMA today. The problems running a Hospital and Practice are scaling up every day and the future also looks not bright for us. So, in this situation we need unity & strength in IMA to take it to the Govt. To me, we look very weak in the eyes of the Govt. We will have to realise our potential and develop it to a formidable force and achieve some results- that needs everyone's contribution and that is not coming up. Even in state council meetings, when important matters discussed many would have left. I think our focus should be very sharp & accurate.

Secondly the membership of IMA. The pace with which members joined IMA earlier became very slow, particularly when many fold numbers of doctors getting graduated in our state. The states like Maharashtra & Kerala who have less number of medical colleges than our state but have more numbers of members. Is it not surprising? We will have to work very hard for this and as you are aware, I started the events towards this even 3 to 4 years ago. If Govt feels we are representing only a portion of doctor's population then we would loose merit.

All the fresh MBBS graduates can become JDN members, if they are reluctant to become a full member, once they come under the ambit of IMA, they can be converted into full membership.

So, I request you all to kindly ponder over there points and suggest ways and means how we can improve in the days to come.

JULY 1 DOCTOR'S Day

July 1 is celebrated as Doctor's Day in memory of Birth and Death Anniversary of the Doyen of Medical Profession Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy (1 July 1882 – 1 July 1962).

- A brilliant student, he passed his entrance examination from Patna Collegiate School in 1897 and FA examination from Patna College in 1899.
- In 1901 he graduated from Patna College with Honors in Mathematics and applied to both Bengal Engineering College Shibpur (now Bengal Engineering and Science University) and Calcutta Medical College (Now Medical College & Hospital Kolkata)
- He got his admission from both institutions but joined Calcutta Medical College as he received their acceptance letter first.
- While at medical school Bidhan came upon an inscription which read, "Whatever thy hands findeth to do, do it with thy might."
- Bidhan was deeply impressed by these words and they became a source of inspiration for him throughout his life.
- Bidhan sailed for England with only Rs. 1200 in February of 1909 intending to enroll himself at St. Bartholomew's to further his education.
- The Dean, reluctant to accept a student from Asia, rejected Bidhan's application. Dr. Roy do mpt loose heart.
- Again and again he submitted his application until finally the Dean, after 30 admission requests, accepted Bidhan to the College.

- Within two years and three months, Bidhan completed his M.R.C.P. and F.R.C.S and returned home from England in 1911.
- On his return he taught at the Calcutta Medical College (now Medical College & Hospital Kolkata), then the Campbell Medical School and finally at the Carmichael Medical College (now R.G. Kar Medical College and Hospital)
- Dr. B.C. Roy played a key role in establishing Indian Institute of Mental Health, infectious Disease Hospital and first ever Postgraduate Medical College in Kolkata.
- He was a competent Physician and a able academician.
- After completing FRCS and MRCP he served as Professor of Medicine, Fellow of American Society of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene and Vice Chancellor of Calcutta University.
- Dr. B.C. Roy's contribution to Medical Profession and Indian Medical Association are immense.
- He was instrumental in starting IMA in the year 1928 and making it the largest professional organisation in the country.
- He served the association in various capacities including National President for two terms.
- Medical Council of India, the governing body of Allopathic Medicine was his brain child and he was the first president in 1939, the position he held till 1945.
- He was known as a great physician before he joined politics. There are innumerable stories about his feats in his profession.
- He acted as a physician in Alipur Central Jail Hospital, when he was interned there as a political prisoner.
- He went to Malaya to extend his helping hand to the Suffering Indians there. He also worked for the sufferers during the infamous Calcutta riots.
- He joined politics inspired by Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Das in 1920.
- He tried his best to industrialise West Bengal. He tried to establish industrial hubs out of Kolkata. Industrial cities of Kalyani and Durgapur are testimony of his visionary ideas.
- It was a really difficult period for West Bengal when he was Chief Minister. The state had to face the gigantic task of rehabilitation of refugees from erstwhile East Pakistan.
- On the political front, he served as member of Bengal Legislative Council, Mayor of Calcutta. He became the first Chief Minister of West Bengal in 1948 and held the position till his death on July 1, 1962.
- Apart being able to deal with the painful issue of rehabilitating the Bengal refugees he strived to hard for the socio economic development and industrial growth of West Bengal.
- In spite of his political schedules, he continued to serve the Medical Profession by devoting one hour everyday for the cause of poor patients and the profession.
- He remained as a bachelor.
- He gifted his house to the people of Bengal in the year 1961.
- The illustrious life and achievements of Dr. B.C. Roy for the cause of Medical Profession, the Society and the Country bestowed him with Bharat Ratna in 1961. Recognising his service the Government of India declared July First as Doctor's Day in India.
- Let us all pledge ourselves once more to serve the Medical Profession and the Country in the golden path shown by Dr. B.C. Roy.
- He was Chief Minister of West Bengal for three terms-from 1948 till his death 1962. ●




28TH. JULY

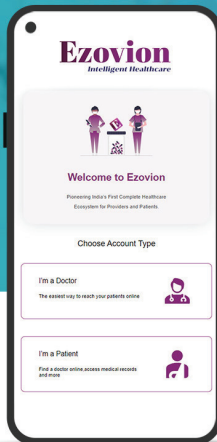

These courses are conducted to empower Practitioners to deliver evidence based medicine to the community, also to acquire more knowledge. This Certificate cannot be registered in the Medical Council nor displayed in the Name Board.

Eligibility : IMA Life Member & IMA CGP Life Member. **Course fee :** Rs. 25,000/- ; **Duration :** 6 Months.

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN RESPIRATORY DISEASE

Course Coordinator : Dr. V. Nandgopal

Online Classes and Onsite Workshops

Curriculum : Basics of Lung Anatomy and Respiratory Physiology, Respiratory Investigations including Basics of Chest X Ray & Spirometry and CT Lungs Basics. 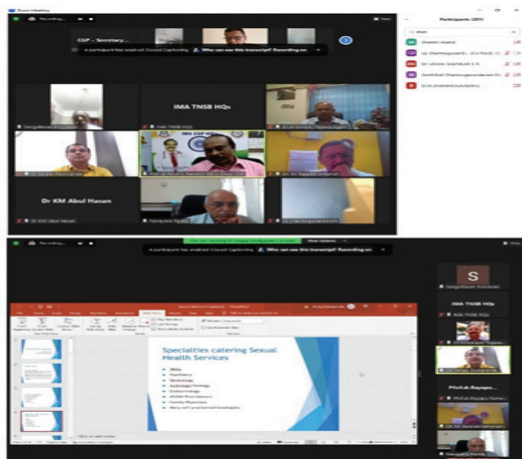

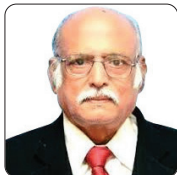
