MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FOR DRIVING LICENSE

For taking the Driving License after applying for Driving License by the individual along with the Driving License they need to submit Medical certificate Form 1A. Upto December 2024, any MBBS Doctor can fill up the form examine the beneficiary and issue the form. From January 2025, in the government transport Authority portal called as Parivahan is instructing that this Medical certificate for the Driving License is to given by Registered doctors in the Parivahan portal only after registration the registered doctors with MBBS qualification or Speciality qualification will become eligible to issue the form 1A Medical certificate so that Registered doctor is called as Empanelled doctors in the parivahan portal. The beneficiaries will search for the doctor and identify the doctor and they will come to meet the registered doctors in the parivahan portal once the beneficiaries approach the doctor, he can examine the beneficiaries and issue the certificate in the portal itself so that this issuing of the Medical certificate is a paperless procedure. The Medical certificate issuing doctor can change the fees and collect it as per the wish. So this is an information to all our IMA members and also registered Medical practitioners to get registered in the parivahan portal and become as an Empanelled doctor. 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Respected IMA TNSB Leaders and members, Greetings.

The academic year 2025-26 began on 01.08.2025. We have about 125 Paramedical Institutions under Paramedical wing of IMA TNSB and we anticipate around 2500 students in this year. Institutions were instructed to finish the admissions at the earliest and start the regular classes soon. Training materials are ready and being issued as and when the admission forms are received.

NHB Hospitals are encouraged to start the Paramedical courses to fulfill their requirements of Paramedics. Any IMA branch by pooling their clinical resources together and having common academic teaching institution can also apply to start Paramedical courses. The fee collected are very minimal, so as to support the poor students' able study these professional courses and stand on their own feet.


IMA TNSB Paramedical courses can be conducted only by the Hospitals registered in NHB having min. 20 beds with necessary class room, apparatus for training with qualified faculties. We have already given 17 new approvals to the Hospitals for the year 2025-26 and few are in a pipeline. Those institutions got approval can enroll the eligible students and submit the admission form to IMA TNSB Paramedical Wing along with the Declaration (Urithi Aavanam) form signed by Parents and the student, 10th Pass mark sheet copy for the 1 year and 2 year courses/ 12th pass mark sheet copy for the 3-year courses, Aadhar copy

with Medical fitness certificate. The admission fee is Rs. 2360/- (Incl GST) per student. The II-year and III-year students are to pay the Tuition fee of Rs. 2360/- within August 2025. The students and the parents are to be explained that the courses conducted by IMA TNSB Paramedical Wing is based on the curriculum of IMA TNSB and the passed-out students can be employed in the Nursing Home Hospitals of IMA /Private Hospitals only. The institutions were instructed to adhere IMA TNSB Paramedical Wings norms to admit the students within the allocated seats. No institute is permitted to admit the students without proper approval. Hence, if any institutions are not renewed its accreditation, should renew the same immediately.

The results for the academic year 2024-25 was already announced, around 95% students were passed the final exam held during June 2025. The failed/absentees can attend the supplementary exam which will held in Sept or November.

We are in a process of upscaling our Paramedical training program by conducting additional Skill development training by the **Tamil Nadu Skill Development Centre for Healthcare (TNASDCH)** under **Vetri Nichayam Scheme of the Govt. of Tamil Nadu. With an additional certificate of the Govt., the Paramedics are empowered and facilitate to promote meaningful employment in the healthcare sector.**

The following topics were discussed in the Insurance Summit.

Common empanelment, Cashless everywhere, Hospital Dispute Redressal Forum and Insurance way forward. We had participants from Insurance companies and tpA's. Had a fruitful discussion regarding further cooperation among us for the betterment of the Industry. Our members raised many doubts- some clarified there itself. Few escalated to the next level. Hope we will find a solution for them soon. We request our members not to sign for unscientific and unviable package rates- the financial viability of our institution will be in danger. At least in each city join together and ask for 10% hike up in package rates every year.

The following topics were discussed in NHB Zonal Meeting:

Fire safety, Minimum wage and other common problems faced by our hospitals. Maintain all records properly. Make sure that the basic pay, DA and allowances are entered correctly in all registers. Those who want to build new hospitals please plan according to latest rules and regulations.

The meeting is followed by **Management committee Meeting**. These are the decisions taken in the meeting.

1. To study in detail about the Trust/Society deed and to have a discussion in Zoom at the earliest before final conclusion.
2. As discussed earlier funds will be transferred to IMA during Land Purchase.
3. CEA renewal to be simplified and to represent for the removal of closure clause, timely FIR and CMCHIS insurance rates regarding.
4. For narcotic/Sprit License to accept CEA certificate and not to ask for any other certificates.
5. To explain in detail to our members regarding Hospital Insurance Redressal Forum.
6. To enquire the need for ramp in other states in Fire Safety Rules.
7. To request all members to sign IMA accepted scientific rates whenever possible for better financial sustainability.

HOW TO RUN HOSPITAL PHARMACIES AND DIAGNOSTIC LABS PROFITABLY IN HOSPITAL SETTING

PHARMACY: Pharmacy & Diagnostic laboratory are revenue earning asset and if managed in right way, the earning could be as high as 50% of total hospital revenue.

1. REGULATORY

Drug control department under the state Government regulates running the pharmacy in Tamilnadu, which state that pharmacy must have registration with state Authority. To register with state authority, Drug department has prescribed certain norms.

- a. Space-Minimum 150 sq. foot, provision for cold storage etc.
- b. Certified pharmacist to manage
- c. Maintenance of Records of selling of scheduled drugs
- d. Regulatory inspection- Periodically drug Inspectors will visit for checking and need to co operate with them
- e. GST. The pharmacy must be an entity like proprietorship and should have GST number to sell products
- f. TDS. If any employee is paid more than the Income tax limit, TDS to be deducted and paid
- g. Income tax return to be filed

2. ISSUES OF RUNNING A PHARMACY

- a. Manpower: • Pharmacist- Qualified manpower is mandatory
 - Accountant qualified
 - Assistants
- b. Stock- adequate stock of more than 10000 medicines [optimum]
- c. Stock rotation: more the rotation, more the profit
- d. Purchase to be done from good company after verifying the Certificate of analysis. Getting better offer increases the profit of high value and fast-moving items
- e. Non-moving stock - This will eat away your profit

- f. Slow moving stock- occasionally prescribed medicines will eat away your profit
- g. Expiry is the sign of inefficient management
- h. Pilferage - This is the major loss-making area. Unless checked by proper regular audit of stock, pharmacy running is a pain.

In summary, efficient staff, smart purchase, optimum stock management. prevention of expiry and pilferage are key element in profitmaking. You should get 30 to 40 percent of your sale as your net profit if you are running your pharmacy efficiently.

DIAGNOSTIC LAB

Un like pharmacy, diagnostic lab plays a key role in doctor's decision making in the diagnosis and management of patient. Hence Profit cannot be the criteria for running the diagnostic laboratory

REGULATORY

There are no regulatory requirement except pollution control tie up and PF, ESI and labor law compliance if the number of employee exceeds 10

- a. Space Requirement Minimum 500 sq. Foot
- b. Man power-Graduates with DMLT degree
- c. Machineries-There are two options. Buying quality machine is paramount important. Rental basis machine will eat away your earnings
- d. Raw material - Purchasing kit at right price makes your lab very profitable. For high-end lab the cost of kits and chemicals should not exceed 25% and lower end lab, it should not exceed 10%. Buying material from reputed company is a must for maintaining quality
- e. QC-quality control is an important function as this decides the quality of result.
- f. Training the people is mandatory as most of the technicians don't understand the clinical importance of a test

g. Quality results - Results can go wrong because of human error, machine error and faulty kit. Running quality control system check will address this.

Diagnostic lab gives low topline but high bottom line.

You should get 20 to 40% of your top line as your net profit depending on your turnover, type of tests and volume of business. Running pharmacy and diagnostic lab professionally will add value to your health care service and huge returns too.

HEALTHCARE DIGITALIZATION

- In district forum We had won 2 no of cases and lost 2 no of cases in July 2025.
- In the state forum we had appealed for 3 cases.

Regarding one of the cases which we lost in district forum (30th June 2025) in Thanjavur, Case of injury due to fall from two-wheeler on 15.09.2022, leading to Right Proximal tibial fracture. He was Operated for the same followed which he Developed compartment syndrome. Six Correction procedures were done for the same in the hospital. As there was

no improvement and as the condition of the complainant was deteriorating the complainant and his relatives insisted for discharge for taking treatment at higher centre. Based on his condition Government of Tamilnadu has issued a disability card with 50% disability.

The complainant had filed this complaint under Sec 35 of Consumer Protection Act, 2019 praying the Commission to award compensation / damages of Rs. 50,00,000/- from the opposite parties in favour of the complainant.

The court had ordered to pay 76 Lakh under various clause citing permanent disability of the complainant, Medical negligence, Procedures without consent and for not properly documenting the same in Discharge summary.

I request all our members to be vigilant in Consent, Documentation and issuing complete and proper Discharge summary which will protect us from the Litigations and Exorbitant compensation awarded by courts (much more than the prayers from the complainant).


