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### **Respected IMA TNSB Leaders and members, Greetings.**

The academic year 2025-26 is going on with full swing since 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025. Colleges/Institutions have been asked to close the admissions by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025. As and when the admissions are received, necessary books are supplied. We have about 125 Paramedical Institutions under Paramedical wing of IMA TNSB for the year 2025-26, and we anticipate around 2500 admissions in this year.

The existing Institutions, which were due for renewal were inspected and issued accreditation. Most of the newly approved institutions were issued with accreditation; few are being issued. The institutions were being issued with the Term plan, so as to teach the uniform pattern of syllabus all over Tamil Nadu. Every institute have to follow the term plan for the teaching and to conduct the term test/ Model test etc.

Every Institute should have trained regular faculties. It is observed that few institutions have inadequate faculties and the students have suffered without proper training. IMA TNSB is finding difficulties even to contact the contact person for any administrative reasons. The Institution/Contact person should have a contact with IMA TN Paramedical Wing through phone and WhatsApp.

It is observed the institutions are requesting for more number of seats for each course what they apply. The Hospital applying for a Paramedical course should have Nursing home board certificate


and min. 20 beds vide Clinical Establishments Act Certification. The Doctor in-charge of the paramedical programme must be a member of IMA. The seats allocated is normally 1/3 of the bed size and the recommendation of the inspecting officer and the facilities available.

The routine online classes will begin from November 2025 onwards. Every Institute should attend the class without any absence by all the students and faculties, irrespective of the subject taught. It is expected, the class teachers/ faculties to encourage the students to concentrate the class and respond to the staff taking class and not to disturb the class during the lecture. Please keep the audio visuals (Computer/Laptop/LCD etc) and broad band ready with good signal strength.

The Convocation for the passed-out students will be held on 16<sup>th</sup> November at IMA Hall, Coimbatore. The certificates will be issued to the final year students. The top scorers and the best performance institutions will be honored.

NHB Hospitals are encouraged to start the Paramedical courses to fulfill their requirements of Paramedics in their hospitals. Any IMA branch by pooling their clinical resources together and having common academic teaching institution can also apply to start Paramedical courses. The fee collected are very minimal, so as to support the poor students' able study these professional courses and stand on their own feet. **MEDICINES:** We have to be very careful in prescribing drugs following the recent cough syrup issue. Please ensure that your prescription is medically and ethically correct. Don't mix Alternative Medicines in Allopathic prescription. Also make sure that your pharmacy person gives the same drug. Look alike and sound alike medicines to be checked again before dispensing. Please check the expiry date in your Pharmacy rack and Physician sample drugs which you have. Be vigilant while giving drug to children. Even a small change in dose will give rise to unexpected complication.

**BMW:** We are getting many queries from our members regarding BMW disposal rates. We are sharing the MOU details in this TIMA. Pay monthly, don't pay annually, then only you can monitor them. Also ask them to sign in BMW register while collecting it-will be checked during CEA renewal. Minimum two to three visits per week is mandatory. Please go through and call us

if any doubt is there. Regarding software and others –we will discuss in detail in our upcoming zonal meeting and share the details with you.

**RENEWALS:** Many of our members haven't yet applied for CEA renewal. Some of our members are asked to show the registers during CEA renewal. Please maintain all the registers properly. Also ensure all your licences are renewed on time.

**INSURANCE:** Many hospital face issue with rates and renewals. We are planning to meet them again. Hope we will get some solution soon. Also some hospitals got mails regarding repayments. Please contact NHB office before paying it.

**WAGES:** Those healthcare facilities with 10 or more employees who haven't registered with ESI can make use of SPREE scheme- though ESIC or Shram Suvidha portal or MCA portal. Please register before 31<sup>st</sup> December to avoid heavy penalties. Pay your staff according to latest GO which we got. Please maintain all registers properly and show them if labour inspector visit our institution.

## **SALIENT FEATURES OF BMW MOU BETWEEN NHB IMA TNSB AND FACILITATORS:**

1. IMA TNSB with NHB TNSB Wings will be the authority to finalize and bring out uniform decisions regarding BMW and Pollution Control Issues pertaining to IMA Members across the State for all the Branches and Stakeholders to follow
2. No deviation is allowed from the decisions taken by the Facilitator or Hospitals / Clinics
3. The rates approved for the Hospitals are as follows
  - a) Irrespective of number of beds if BMW generation is >250 gms/bed/per day charges will be on weight basis
  - b) If <250 gms / bed/ per day charges will on per bed / day basis.
  - c) It is the collective responsibility of the Hospitals and Service Providers to weigh the BMW, record and sign in the register
  - d) Rs.10 / bed / day and Rs.40 / Kg
  - e) No payment if their visits are less than 50%
4. The rates approved for the Clinics are as follows
  - a) Visit should be at least twice a week
  - b) Rs.1200 for part time clinics and Rs.1800 for full time clinics per month,
  - c) Two months fee can be collected as advance. Bills to be generated
  - d) monthly and collect payment
5. Decisions regarding Consultation Rooms are as follows
  - a) Should not generate BMW
  - b) No need for BMW disposal Services
6. Bags& Bar-coding Rates
  - a) Should be uniform for all Hospitals / Clinics and will be fixed after Studying the market
7. The above made decisions will be effective from July 1st 2023
8. Bio Medical Plastics including saline bottles to be handed over to CBMWTF only, and this should be instructed to the Members by IMA TNSB/NHB.
9. Sharps should be disposed through the Bar-Coded Sharp Disposal Container only.
10. New Establishments should be given consent within one month of application.
11. Whenever a New Establishment is approaching the BMW Facilitator, it should be ascertained that they become the Member of IMA TNSB / NHB as for as possible.
12. The above rates are applicable only for IMA TNSB & NHB Members.
13. Hereafter it is decided to give 7.5% Increase in the rate every year by July 1st at Cumulative basis.
14. It is decided to work in Coordination to face the problems from the public, PCB and Government either by the facilitator or by IMA TNSB / NHB Member Hospitals and Vice versa.
15. The Facilitators are advised to utilize the services of IMA TNSB / NHB State Office Bearers, NHB District Coordinators and NHB Assistant secretaries of Branches he never they face some issues with the IMA TNSB /NHB Member Hospitals regarding BMW.

# **HOSPITAL ESTABLISHMENTS**

## **MINIMUM WAGES RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **WHAT IS MINIMUM WAGES?**

The minimum amount of remuneration that an employer is required to pay wage earners for the work performed during a given period. It cannot be reduced by collective agreement or an individual contract.

**WORKING HOURS-** 9-12 hours with spread over.

**CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT :** Wages shall be paid on working day within 7 days of the end of wages period (or) within 10 days if 1000 or more persons are employed.

### **HOLIDAYS**

- The employers shall allow a day of rest with wages to the employee every week
- Rates of Minimum wages – Employment in hospital and nursing homes
- Not applicable to Government Hospital & Employers State Insurance Dispensaries.
- The rates of minimum wages varies based on the number of beds available in the Hospital
- The rates vary according to Zones.

### **OVER TIME WAGES**

- Any work beyond 8 hours in a day & 48 hours in a week attract over –time wages at double the normal wage rates.
- Display of Abstract of minimum wages Act. 1948 by an employ in a conspicuous place.

### **PAYMENT OF GRAUTUITY ACT, 1972**

- Applicable to those employing 20 or more persons.

- It makes provision for payment of Gratuity to an employee at the rate of 15 days wages per year of service if the employee resigns or his service are terminated (Provided he has put in at least 5 years continuous Service)

### **PAYMENT OF BONUS ACT, 1965**

- Applicable to those employing 10 or more employees.
- Minimum bonus payable under the Act – 8.33% of earnings of an employee in the accounting year of Hospital / Establishment.
- Maximum bonus payable -20% of such earning of employee

### **INDUSTRIAL DISPUTER ACT 1947**

- If any employee works for more than 240 days in a year, His termination becomes “retrenchment” and he will have to be paid one month is notice & retrenchment compensation at rate of 15 days wages per year of service.
- No temporary employee should be engaged for more than 6 months.

### **THE CHILD AND ADOLECENT LABOUR (PROHIBITION AND REGULATION ACT, 2016)**

- No Child below 14 years of age can work in Hospital, if so the employer attracts fine or imprisonment or both.
- Adolescents cannot work in hazardous processes and in non-hazardous works, the employer can employ the adolescents with prior notice to Inspector.

### **THE MATERNITY BENEFIT ACT**

- Women employees are entitled to the benefits of this act.

- A woman must have been working as an employee for at least 80 days within part 12 months.
- Applicable to those employing 10 or more workers
- The abstract of this act should be displayed
- Muster roll - Form A should be maintained.

**THE TAMIL NADU INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS (NATIONAL AND FESTIVALHOLIDAYS) ACT, 1958**

- According to this act, an employee works on a festival or National holiday, should be entitled to twice the wages or wages for the Holiday and substituted holiday with wages on any other day.
- NFH - Holidays includes - January 26. May 1, August 15 and October 2.

**EQUAL REMUNERATION RULES, 1976**

- It is the duty of employer to pay equal remuneration to men and women workers for same work or of a similar nature.
- Penalty - Rs. 10000 or imprisonment of 1 moth or both.

**These are some of the registers to be maintained in the Institution:**

Form U - Register of Employees - This register lists all employees of the establishment. .

Form V - Register of employment - This register tracks details about employee employment.

Form x - Register of Leave and social security benefit - his register keeps track of leave and social security benefits provided to employees.

Form W - Register of Wages -This register records wages paid to employees.

Form S - Employers are required to maintain a Register of Employees with Hours of Work -This register tracks the daily and weekly working hours of each employee, and is a crucial record for compliance with the Act's provisions on working hours

Others are as its applicable central act registers.
